THUNDER GAL angled out entering the backstretch to stalk the leaders from four wide, rallied into the lane to collar the leaders through midstretch and was edging clear late. CHOCOLATE DIVA prompted the pace from outside MS. BUMPER throughout, continued with the winner through midstretch but could not handle that one. MS. BUMPER made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail then weakened some late while drifting in near the wire. VICTORY TOUCH dropped back off the pace racing out from the rail, came inside through the lane to close then steadied and altered outward nearing the wire as MS. BUMPER drifted in. BRAHMS SONG failed to mount a bid racing three to four wide. MEXICAN TIME prompted the pace from three wide to the far turn and tired.
