BLUMIN MEMORIES set all the pace from the outside and prevailed in the drive under all out pressure. PRIME BLUFF stalked the pace, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to just miss. TRINAS THREE D'S was bumped at the start, raced towards the inside throughout and finished willingly to the wire. MISS STRYKER was hustled along from the inside and weakened. BLACK AND FANCY raced in tight quarters at the start, moved up three wide and never was a serious factor. CONNIE'S KITTY reared at the start, was bumped hard, lost an iron briefly soon after the start, raced four deep and never menaced. HUSKER RIDGE was bumped at the start, checked briefly at the nine sixteenths pole and tired in the latter stages.
