TAP DANCING MAUK settled back off the early leaders to stalk in good striking position, moved out to take clear aim at the top pair in late backstretch, continued four wide on the far turn then responded when set down nearing the stretch to wear those two down and move clear under strong urging. MOTION APPROVED shadowed the early pace set by YOURMONEYSNOGOOD from outside, moved to challenge through the second turn and engage in a duel up the backstretch, continued head and head the remainder then could not handle the winner in the closing yards. YOURMONEYSNOGOOD showed in front into the first turn and made the running while out from the rail, was engaged by MOTION APPROVED entering the backstretch, continued to duel that one the remainder and was outnodded for the place late. ALWAYS NOBLE saved ground while unhurried early, angled out to rally three wide into the lane then could not close on the top ones late. TRICKYVILLE DEW broke last with no mishap, saved ground just off the early leaders and weakened through the far turn. HIGH FLEET was just off the early leaders racing outside and had nothing left when the real running began. AL'S DEARLY BRED trailed racing three and four wide.
