Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; Of \$40,000 at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs.; Of \$30,000 in 2006, 6 lbs.; Of \$15,000 in 2005-06, 8 lbs. Maiden and Claiming races not considered in weight allowances. High Weights Preferred (on the scale). Total earnings in 2005-06 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Closed Wednesday, April 19, 2006 with fifty-nine (59) nominations.

WALLY'S CHOICE brushed with HABANEROS at the start, settled back off the leaders racing about three wide, moved to contention in traffic through the far turn then awaited room nearing the stretch, came inside MOTION APPROVED to challenge and offered up a strong late run to surge clear under steady handling. MOTION APPROVED stalked the leaders racing three to four wide, moved to challenge into the far turn, edged clear turning for home then could not handle the winner's late run while clearly second best. STORMY BUSINESS settled outside in good position, made his move to challenge from four wide heading up the backstretch to loom a threat through the far turn into the lane but could not sustain the effort. HABANEROS brushed with the winner at the start, settled back inside that one to save ground to late backstretch, angled out to move four wide into the lane but lacked a final run. DRAGOONER was part of the pace while four or five wide outside both TONIGHT RAINBOW and JIMMY BOND, settled back on the second turn then rallied back to show in front late backstretch but tired through the far turn. JIMMY BOND was on the pace from between rivals and tired through the far turn. TONIGHT RAINBOW was on the pace from inside rivals while placed about the three or four path, edged clear after a half mile but tired. HIGH FLEET raced in striking position while saving ground in behind the pace dispute but tired nearing the far turn.
