FERGIESSSHARKATTACK set all the pace from the inside and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. HIGH INVESTMENT stalked the pace, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. GREEN'S FAIR stalked the pace, saved ground throughout, raced in tight at the quarter pole and finished willingly to the wire. TANNA GOLD pressed the pace and weakened in the drive. NAFIR'S LAD raced five wide in the lane and never menaced. SECO EXPRESS was slow early and never threatened. MAD MONEY failed to sustain a bid. SHAYNE'S HERO showed brief foot from the outside and tired readily.
