RECKLESS POLLY disputed the pace from outside FOXIE AN FUN to edge clear through the far turn then was roused through upper stretch and held the margin to the wire. FOXIE AN FUN forced the pace from inside the winner to the far turn then could not match strides in the lane. NOSARA stalked the leaders racing three wide and weakened. LULIN settled back off the pace racing three wide, angled five wide into the lane and moved up but could not threaten. GAMBLING LADY LUCK broke inward to bump with a rival, stalked the pace racing four and five wide to bid into the far turn but could not sustain the run. GAZY GIRL was five wide in the first turn, settled outside and weakened. DESIGNED TO RUN failed to mount a solid bid racing three wide then steadied between rivals nearing the lane. HALF TEMPTED saved ground and tired. LAWYER LYNN bobbed then was bumped at the start and failed to threaten racing three wide. EASY LOU raced three and four wide and was always outrun.
