BUDDY GEORGE settled back off the pace racing three wide, saved ground through the far turn then angled back out to move between rivals from four wide, rallied through the lane and was up in the closing yards. THEE HEMI settled just off the dueling leaders racing four and five wide, rallied back to challenge into the far turn, made the lead inside the sixteenth marker then could not hold the winner safe late. INCREDIBLE AFFAIR settled back off the pace racing outside, rallied six wide into the lane and made a good late run to be closing in but was too late. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR showed speed between rivals through the first turn, settled back to track in good position racing three and four wide, angled five wide into the lane and continued willingly but could not reach the top ones. ANOTHER BUMPER dueled on the pace racing out from the rail and inside KALEBS ABLUMIN, continued to vie to midstretch and came up empty in the closing sixteenth. KALEBS ABLUMIN dueled on the pace from outside ANOTHER BUMPER to the far turn and weakened nearing the lane. HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY broke into the side of the gate and was always back racing four and five wide. PEPPY PELINI stalked the pace while saving ground and tired.
