Footnotes

PATS HIGH LIFE forced the pace from outside BUBBLE B. BUDDHA to bid into the far turn, edged clear turning for home then just held as PEACEFIELDS made his late run. PEACEFIELDS was five wide in the first turn, settled outside to stalk the pace in good position, made his bid four wide into the lane and was quickly getting to the winner late. JUDGE FUDGE stalked the pace in good position from three wide and lacked a final closing response. BUBBLE B. BUDDHA broke outward then moved to a short lead from along the inside, continued with the winner to late in the far turn and came up empty late. DON'T BLUFF was towards the back racing three and four wide, moved up in the far turn then lugged in turning for home and continued to improve position. TIDAL STORM stumbled after the break then was hung seven wide into the first turn, remained outside and moved up while not a threat. RED ROCK BLUFF was shuffled back between rivals at the break, saved ground to the far turn then checked from between rivals in traffic. MAGNIFICENT BLUFF saved ground just off the leaders early, steadied as a rival lugged in after straightening for home and dropped back. COMMANDING ACE broke in to the side of the gate, followed the pace while three or four wide and weakened. AVELINA'S TICKET was six wide between rivals into the first turn and steadied then dropped back.
