Footnotes

MISS MISSILE forced the pace from outside JASPER'S VALENTINE to move clear through the far turn and take command then was under moderate urging to hold the margin through the lane. GRACIE JANE tracked the pace just off the early leaders, moved nearest the winner through the far turn but could not menace in the lane. JASPER'S VALENTINE contested the pace from inside the winner while racing in the three or four path, angled in through the far turn and weakened. ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE lacked a closing bid racing three and four wide. SALTY ATTRACTION failed to mount a bid racing four and five wide. RIDE THE WAVE failed to threaten racing out from the rail. SLEWPY GIRL stalked the pace from outside and weakened. JANE OF ARCADIA was not a factor. DAZZLING SEVILLE was bumped by a rival at the start then checked from between rivals when in tight entering the first turn and failed to threaten. DEPUTY'S WHIRL broke outward to bump with a rival then ducked into the gap entering the main track, unseated her rider then crashed over the inner rail and ran loose in the infield during the race.
