FAREWELL BROADWAY pressed the pace, raced three deep and finished gamely to be clear under strong pressure. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished second best. C. O. AL was slow early, moved up three wide in the stretch and gained ground gamely in the latter stages. SILVER WILDCAT set all the pace and weakened a bit in the drive. HALO'S ROCKET pressed the pace from the inside and weakened. WALLSTREETGANGSTER dropped back early, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and never was a serious threat. BLUMIN WON raced three deep and had no response. END ZONE was slow early and never menaced. RUN OVER ME RADE showed little. DANDY DIAMOND reared at the start, stalked the pace and tired.
