NANA SISSY ZANDER stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to be clear under strong pressure. JUST MAID set all the pace along the inside and finished second best. STORMY ARKY dropped back early, was blocked nearing the quarter pole, swung out five wide in the stretch and gained ground gamely in the final stages. R CHARMED AFFAIR stalked the pace, saved ground and had no late winning bid. CONNIE'S KITTY pressed the pace and gave way. SILVERLAKE PATTY was slow early, raced six wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. TARTAR SAUCE stalked the pace, took up at the eighth pole and weakened in the stretch. CAROL'S FRIEND raced seven wide into the upper stretch and never was a factor. SHEZ SEEING STARS reared at the start and never menaced.
