HOLIDAY BUZZ settled back off the pace racing two and three wide, moved closer going to the far turn while angling out, rallied six wide into the lane and closed with a good late run to prevail in the closing jump. SEAL OF THE PEARL stalked the pace racing three wide in good position, moved to challenge going to the far turn, found traffic and steadied late in that bend, altered course up the rail into the lane to lead deep stretch and just failed to last. KENTUCKY MILE stalked the pace from four wide to bid into the final turn, vied into the lane then was outfinished for position late. GUTS broke into the side of the gate, saved ground in reach of the pace, angled out leaving the second turn, rallied and made his bid going to the final turn then continued well but was outfinished for position. GEOCACHE stalked the leaders from three or four wide in good position, continued evenly but lacked the needed late response. JUNGLE RAJ moved to a long lead in the early going, made the pace to nearing the stretch and had little left. HOWARD COUNTY HANK saved ground for over six furlongs, angled four and five wide heading up the backstretch but failed to mount a rally. TOOTS AND DAZZLES followed the pace from four wide and tired.
