Footnotes

YANKEE CONNECTION stalked the leaders from good position outside to bid four and five wide into the lane and moved off under a mild hand ride. BOXERS OR BRIEFS stalked the leaders while three or four wide then rallied clear for the place but could not get to the winner. RISNER RED showed speed from outside GRANT TOWN BLUES to move clear early into the backstretch, continued on a short lead through the far turn and came up empty in the lane. GRANT TOWN BLUES settled out from the rail to stalk the leader then lacked a closing response. ABEL WINAPRIZE followed the pace racing three wide and failed to mount a bid. TIGERSTARK trailed to the far turn and moved up while three or four wide but could not threaten. STORMY HEATH was five wide in the first turn and failed to threaten. SIR THUNDER was not a factor. MR. FROSTY CAT saved ground and was outrun. BYARS SO COOL saved ground and tired.
