Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in weight allowances. High Weights Preferred, on the scale. Total earnings in 2010-11 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Closed Saturday, April 30 with seventeen nominations.

ALYWYN settled back off the early pace racing three and four wide in good position, rallied strongly while moving five wide into the far turn, remained well out in the track to give the riderless horse a wide berth in the far turn, drew off nearing the lane and was under a mild hand ride then was taken in hand nearing the wire. SMART ROAR was five wide in the first turn then was forced in and bumped with MILITARY MOTHER as the riderless horse lugged in while looping the field heading up the backstretch, chased the winner home and held second late. GRACIE JANE settled towards the back racing three wide, angled six wide into the lane and made a late to run narrowly miss the place. MILITARY MOTHER was just off the early pace racing three to four wide when forced in and bumped as SMART ROAR was forced in by the riderless horse, continued evenly the remainder but could not hold position. SNOW TRIP saved ground and moved up late while not a threat. PROSPECTORS ALYCAT saved ground in reach of the early pace and weakened. RUBY'S BIG BAND was not a factor racing four wide. NAYBORHOOD AFFAIR stalked the pace from four wide and tired. EAST TO EDEN showed the most early speed racing about the three path and tired in the far turn. SMOKY BELLE stumbled to her nose and threw her rider at the start, ran loose to loop the field through the first turn and heading up the backstretch, came in on rivals near the three-eighths marker then caused no further problems.
