### Footnotes

DIAMOND DID IT moved to a clear lead in the opening furlong racing about the three path, widened heading up the backstretch then held a safe margin under a moderate hand ride through the lane. RULE OF TWELFTHS broke in the air to come away last and raced well back while three wide early, rallied through the far turn then angled out some in the lane and gained the place while unable to threaten the winner. MORNING'S PROMISE followed the pace racing two to three wide and failed to offer a solid closing bid. CATTY BUDDHA trailed early while void of speed, angled out in the far turn to launch an eight wide rally into the lane but was too late to threaten. LADY SISTER ANNA saved ground and lacked a rally. ONE CAR FUNERAL saved ground and was not a threat. MONEY TAK was midpack while outside and failed to threaten from seven wide into the lane. HALF MOON LADY came out in the first turn to bump with a rival, followed the pace racing four to five wide and had no bid. LUMBER QUEEN chased the pace racing three and four wide and tired. REALLYTWISTED was bumped in the first turn, stalked the pace early while four to five wide and tired.
