Footnotes

GO FOR COVER tracked the pace racing three to four wide to make his bid into the far turn, drew clear through that bend then was under some urging to maintain the advantage. MR UNTOUCHABLE settled back off the pace racing four wide, moved closer going to the far turn and continued to rally through the lane to move clear for the place. CRAFTMASTER was just off the pace racing three to four wide and lacked a final closing response. GOLD GUY angled out heading up the backstretch to move four and five wide in the far turn and improve position while not a serious threat. FAST MAX moved clear into the first turn, made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail and weakened in the drive. KEPTHECABIN saved ground to the far turn, angled four wide to move up while not a threat. SUGARDAZZLE stalked the early pace from five wide and tired. DAN DEE DART saved ground in reach of the pace for a half and tired. BOOTDIM threw his head just prior to the start and became tangled in gate to lose all chance. SEA SALTY RUN stalked the early pace from outside and tired.
