Footnotes

CAMPO JOTI bumped at the break, shared the early speed while toward the outside, moved clear into the bend and gradually opened up under a hand ride in the late going. BECKY'S RETURN gradually angled in on the backstretch, had the rail on the turn, battled for second in the stretch and got the nod at the wire. SUNTAN BABY in contention early, failed to keep up while just off the inside on the bend, fanned out some entering the lane, fought for second between rivals and narrowly missed in a game effort. HEAVENLY SUNLIGHT broke inward, bumping CAMPO JOTI, was kept close from outside, advanced three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to path five for the stretch run and was making up ground on the second flight through the waning yards. CHAMPAGNE SHIMMY hustled from inside, saved ground through the turn, altered out to path four for room inside the last furlong but could not close the gap. ALASKAN HOT ROD was soon well back, just off the inside taking the bend and failed to have a stretch bid. CLASSIC RETURN broke slowly and fought the rider briefly, stayed off the inside on the turn, floated out to path four into the lane and was checked as she weaved between a fallen horse and her jockey inside the last eighth. LONG STORY SHORT broke alertly, vied for the lead briefly between rivals, could not stay with CAMPO JOTI entering the turn, was in path four entering the stretch, fell just inside the furlong marker and was vanned off. DUSTY CART wheeled at the break, was pulled up and walked off. There was a stewards' inquiry into DUSTY CART'S start and the fall LONG STORY SHORT took midstretch. After their review, no action was taken.
