Footnotes

MR. SASS contested the pace between rivals, did not stay with RICOCHET ANDY on the bend, gradually angled inside, gained a clear path into the stretch, took the lead nearing the eighth pole, was clear soon after, under steady urging and held off COACH ABS. The latter, a bit slow at the break, was then bumped, moved up quickly between horses, was two then three wide taking the turn, found himself behind RICOCHET ANDY, altered inside that one midstretch, was all out the last eighth and pulled clear for second. TALLBOYS TAVERN steadied in traffic near the half mile pole, angled in entering the bend, was just off the rail into the stretch, his rider lost his whip at the head of the lane, was forced in by COACH ABS midstretch, battled for third the last furlong and secured it nearing the wire. CART'S LAST CHANCE broke outward, bumping COACH ABS, was prominent between horses, in path four taking the turn, had an easy striking position with a furlong to go, fought for third instead and was narrowly outfinished. RICOCHET ANDY also broke outward, bumped ILLINI DESTINY, set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved clear on the bend, floated out to path three entering the lane, could not hold back MR. SASS midstretch and slowly yielded. PALACE TENOR without early foot between horses, was just off the inside on the turn, fanned out four wide for the drive, made up ground, altered outside CART'S LAST CHANCE after entering the last eighth and finished evenly. ILLINI DESTINY bobbled a bit at the break then was bumped, soon moved inside, saved ground taking the bend, advanced upper stretch then leveled off. WILDMAN MAC was an early factor from outside, lost ground six wide through the turn and steadily faded in the lane. PRINCE DON soon trailed from inside, floated out some entering the stretch, was gradually angled out in the late going and made up minor ground. SANDS RED BARON a brief factor toward the outside, began to fade five wide on the turn, swung out widest for the drive and continued to give way.
