Footnotes

EL BROKCO hustled clear, showed the way along or just off the inside, lengthened command under urging on the bend and was kept to task to the wire. PIMM'S O'CLOCK in contention between horses, was in paths three or four through the turn, all out in the lane and gained second in the waning yards. JUMP 'IEN rated between rivals early, was angled in on the bend, was blocked behind traffic at the head of the lane, had to alter his path repeatedly as he rallied and caught BETATRON for third near the wire. BETATRON bumped with DEW DETIME at the break, raced in the second flight between horses, three wide taking the turn, moved clear for second upper stretch, was no match for EL BROKCO the last eighth, finished evenly and lost the place then the show. DEW DETIME quickly overcame bumping at the start, was prominent toward the outside, lost ground four wide on the turn, floated out further into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. BULLBUCK well placed inside from the early going, weakened for the drive. BOSTON OUTLAW made a small lunge from the gate, appeared difficult to control the first furlong, saved ground taking the bend and was gradually angled out inside the final furlong. NICKY'S DELIGHT void of speed from outside, followed DEW DETIME into the turn, swung out widest for the stretch run and made up minor ground late.
