Footnotes

SIMPLY THE FOX showed first, shared the lead from outside, was two wide through the bend, shook off SHINY STAR upper stretch, put to urging with a furlong to go and steadily opened up on the rest. SHINY STAR contested the pace just inside SIMPLY THE FOX, gained the rail into the turn, could not stay with the latter upper stretch, began to wear down in the late going and narrowly held onto second. LIL VALRIE SUE TOO in the second flight from inside, came off the rail some entering the lane, angled out to path three midstretch and was getting to the weakening SHINY STAR in the waning yards. WINDS DUE EAST void of speed toward the outside, advanced three wide on the turn, fanned outside LIL VALRIE SUE TOO for the stretch run, found best stride too late the last furlong but proved easily best of the rest. RUN WILLA RUN soon trailed from outside, stayed well off the inside taking the turn, came five wide into the stretch and passed tired ones. ETVOOPRAYPARTAY in midpack on the backstretch, failed to keep up just off the rail through the turn, forced in some after entering the last eighth and had no late bid. TREAT GRANY WRIGHT without early foot while toward the outside, was three wide taking the bend, angled in under a stern right whip after entering the last eighth then was altered out in the waning yards. I DON'T THINK SO chased the pacesetters from outside, just off the rail on the turn, fanned out some into the lane, began to tire, altered in as LIL VALRIE SUE TOO came out midstretch and continued to yield. BELLA MICHELLE a step slow at the start, was never a factor in a ground-saving trip.
