**Footnotes**

PASS THE MONEY shared the lead just off the inside, was roused on the turn, moved ahead leaving the bend, lengthened his lead under urging upper stretch and held off MAPLE AVENUE under steady handling. MAPLE AVENUE chased the pacesetters from outside on the backstretch, angled in entering the bend, was just off the inside into the lane, altered outside PASS THE MONEY upper stretch, all out, steadily closed the gap and proved easily second best. MING GLO trailed from inside, came off the rail some for the stretch run, lacked a significant bid but moved clear for third inside the final sixteenth. RYANS JOY disputed the pace from inside, could not stay with PASS THE MONEY leaving the turn and steadily wore down along through the stretch.
