Footnotes

NAFIR'S BEST kept close between horses, took over two wide leaving the bend, was clear entering the lane and maintained control under a drive. CUARTO CUATES chased from between rivals, was just off the inside on the turn, swung five wide into the lane, gradually lugged in as he rallied and pulled away for the place deep stretch. NAPI in contention from inside, did not keep up on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, altered back to the rail inside the final furlong and squeezed through inside TOFASTFORTARGET to gain third late. TOFASTFORTARGET broke alertly but was steadied as he tried to lug in just after the break, quickly recovered to gain a clear lead, had the rail on the turn, was overtaken leaving the bend, floated out some entering the stretch and gradually yielded. HIGH'R VOLTAGE without speed from inside, angled toward the outside upper stretch and steadily improved position without threatening. SAM THE RAM pressed from between horses, was three wide on the turn then wore down for the drive. MAPLE AVENUE prominent from outside on the backstretch, began to tire three wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run, altered in some nearing the eighth pole to stay clear of CUARTO CUATES and continued to fade. HI YO SILVER AWAY chased from outside, was three to five wide through the bend, angled out further for a clear path upper stretch, altered out as HIGH'R VOLTAGE came close near the eighth pole and had little to offer. WHAMMY'S BOY in contention early, advanced along the rail on the turn but tired for the drive. HIGH HEIR was soon well back, stayed off the inside taking the turn and had no late bid.
