### Footnotes

ZAVILL stalked from between horses, went for the lead along the rail on the turn, had the advantage as he floated out into the lane, moved clear, was gradually getting out but held sway. HALF MILER pressed from outside, bid three wide on the bend, was carried out to path five into the stretch, gradually angled out while all out, could not close the gap on the leader but was easily second best. PASS THE MONEY prominent from the beginning, was widest taking the turn, no match for the top pair in the stretch but pulled clear for third the final sixteenth. PROPANE in midpack early, saved ground through the turn and failed to have a significant stretch bid. WHAMMY'S BOY sent clear, was challenged from both sides on the turn, yielded as he angled out leaving the bend, moved inside ZAVILL upper stretch and continued to fade. FOX RAP without speed between rivals, followed WHAMMY'S BOY through the bend and had no late bid. N EIGHTEEN steadied behind traffic from inside into the turn, came off the rail some, was three wide into the stretch and improved position a bit without threatening. EAGLE EYE JUSTICE without speed toward the outside, was three wide into the bend, swung out to path six for the stretch run and had little to offer. JADE MAN void of speed, was boxed in along the rail on the turn and failed to have a late bid. AIDAN'S SLEW angled out early, stayed wide through the turn and was empty for the drive.
