Footnotes

SMART ALEX'S POSSE caught in tight quarters and jostled a bit between rivals going to the turn, came four wide into the lane, weaved around traffic as he rallied and swept past STUDLEY DORIGHT the last thirty yards. STUDLEY DORIGHT soon gained the lead, stayed off the inside through the bend, was put to a drive the last furlong but could not hold off SMART ALEX'S POSSE. IVAN'S JOY chased from between horses, took the rail into the bend, swung outside STUDLEY DORIGHT for the drive and lacked the extra needed. WINNINGCHEROKEE bumped at the start, jostled with SMART ALEX'S POSSE going to the turn, was three wide on the bend, swung out widest for the stretch run and lugged in late as he gradually closed the gap. R RICH E. RICH just off the inside, improved position some upper stretch then leveled off. CRYPTO GULCH stumbled outward at the start, bumping WINNINGCHEROKEE, advanced from inside on the turn, fanned five wide into the lane, altered out widest upper stretch for room and improved position some. BLING KING hustled along while prominent between rivals, began to yield three wide leaving the bend, floated out further into the stretch, drifted out some going to the eighth pole, held a straight path in the late going but had little left. TIO CHENCHO made a small leap from the gate, showed no speed from outside, angled in on the bend and had little to offer just off the inside through the stretch. CAP'N FELIX chased from outside, could not keep up four wide on the turn, fanned out further into the lane and steadily gave way. T L S LIGHTNING was soon well back, lost ground through the turn and was empty for the drive.
