Footnotes

ALASKAN PARADOX broke inward, bumping RETAIL, chased from inside, waited for room on the turn, got through along the rail leaving the bend, moved clear inside the final furlong and held off TACTICS RAP under a steady drive. TACTICS RAP chased from between horses, was just off the inside entering the bend, gradually angled out for room leaving the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was all out, came up short but proved easily second best. COOL KID in the second flight, went for the lead two wide on the turn, was carried out some into the lane and began to wear down the last eighth. FREAK OUT soon moved clear, was challenged from outside leaving the turn, drifted out some entering the stretch, could not hold back ALASKAN PARADOX midstretch and weakened in the late going. PERPETUA steadied behind traffic shortly after the break, advanced between horses to threaten three wide on the turn, fanned to path six for the drive and could not sustain her bid. SWIFT MELVA without speed, angled inside on the bend and lacked a significant stretch bid. RETAIL bumped at the break, was void of speed, though hustled along, stayed off the rail taking the turn and also failed to rally in the lane. LIL LINDA LU fractious in the gate, chased from outside and proved unresponsive the last quarter mile.
