Footnotes

WILDLY LANA set a pressured pace between rivals, moved ahead and saved ground through the bend then gradually opened up under steady urging in the lane. I'MA ROCKIN BULL pressed from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, could not close the gap on the leader in the stretch but was clearly second best. ROKEE saved ground throughout and moved ahead for third deep stretch. GOOD WINNINGS hesitated at the break, swung out widest on the turn then steadily advanced in the stretch. DONTFLATERYOURSELF without early speed, saved ground on the turn, swung out three wide into the stretch and passed between tiring rivals. SIX SIXTY caught in tight quarters approaching the turn, jostled with SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL near the half mile marker, was just off the inside on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch, fought for third but did not have enough left. PRINCESS FREEDOM bumped with SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL at the start, was an early factor between rivals, four wide leaving the turn then flattened out for the drive. CAN'T MAKE ME prominent between horses, moved to the inside on the turn then tired in the lane. HIT A BAD NOTE well off the inside throughout, failed to menace. SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL in tight approaching the turn, jostled with SIX SIXTY near the half mile pole, was shuffled back, three wide on the turn and gave way the last quarter mile.
