THACKER HENRY broke alertly and gradually angled in from the front end, lengthened his lead on the turn and maintained full control under a drive. GIVING POINTS rated from outside, commenced his bid widest on the turn and got up for second in the waning yards. IMMINENT STORM bumped a couple times early, edged ahead for the second along the rail on the turn, moved clear for that position upper stretch but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. UNO MACHO MAN lugged in shortly after the break, bumped IMMINENT STORM, was caught in crowding and bumped the latter again before finishing a furlong, fought for second between horses, came three wide into the stretch, began to wear down and gradually lugged in the last eighth. COOKIE CZAR away a bit slowly, advanced from inside on the turn and was altered out inside the last eighth to stay clear of UNO MACHO MAN. SECRETO'S GOLD steadied behind traffic just after the break, trailed just off the inside and lacked a significant stretch response. BIG BULL in contention just off the inside, failed to keep up on the turn, swung out widest for the drive and had little to offer. WESTERN FUN an early factor from outside, faded three wide on the bend.
