**Footnotes**

PASS THE MONEY hustled up from outside, took over four wide on the bend, angled in some entering the lane and shook off TIP FROM SKIP under a drive the last furlong. TIP FROM SKIP contested the pace between rivals, gained the rail on the turn, lost a narrow advantage, slowly yielded the final eighth but stayed clear for the place. PALM SPRINGS disputed the pace between horses, was three then four wide through the turn, lacked the extra needed for the drive but was unchallenged for third. SPURTABILITY without speed just off the inside, gradually swung out through the turn and improved position five wide in the lane. PALACHEE broke in the air, stumbled shortly after that, appearing to clip SPURTABILITY'S heels, chased from inside, came off the rail some into the bend and passed tired ones in the stretch. MYGRANDPAISADEACON bumped with SLICK MICK at the start, was prominent from inside but tired for the drive. SLICK MICK jostled then squeezed at the start, soon trailed from outside, angled in on the bend and lacked a significant stretch response. LUCKY ALEC displayed early speed between rivals, began to tire two wide on the turn, fanned out some for the entering the lane, was steadied briefly upper stretch when SEMI PRO crossed his path and continued to fade. SEMI PRO broke inward, jostled briefly with SLICK MICK, was an early factor between horses, could not keep up while behind LUCKY ALEC on the turn, altered outside that one leaving the bend, altered in for a clear path upper stretch and gave way between rivals the last eighth.
