Footnotes

LUCY'S MISS rated from inside, swung outside CHARLENES ANGEL for the stretch run, responded to urging, took over inside the eighth pole, continued to lengthen her lead and was in hand the last seventy yards. UMMA UMMA in midpack early just off the inside, progressed two wide on the turn and took over second from inside late. MORE THE MARI'ER broke inward, was settled, advanced three wide on the turn, altered out to path five upper stretch, lodged a mild bid and caught CHARLENES ANGEL for third near the wire. CHARLENES ANGEL broke in stride and was soon clear, stayed off the inside through the bend and gradually wore down between horses in the lane. ANAKA was steadied behind traffic after the break, just off the inside entering the turn, fanned out to path five entering the stretch, was blocked with a furlong left, got through outside MORE THE MARI'ER nearing the sixteenth marker and closed the gap some. POLLY THE DOLLY was void of speed though hustled along from inside, came off the rail some for the stretch run but lacked a late bid. PEPPERCART in midpack between horses on the backstretch, swung out six wide for the drive and gradually faded. CONSIDER THEMEX failed to menace in a wide trip.
