Footnotes

SULTRY DEMEANOR showed first, disputed the pace well off the rail but inside his challenger, took the inside entering the bend, shook off HURRICANE VAMP when asked upper stretch and held on under steady handling. SPURTABILITY bobbled a bit at the break, was rated from inside, picked up his pace on the turn, altered out after entering the final furlong, closed well but came up short. HIGH HEIR bumped shortly after the start, was boxed in on the turn, came off the rail some entering the stretch then had to weave through traffic to advance. DOCALOT disputed the pace just outside SULTRY DEMEANOR but weakened for the drive. KNOB CREEK advanced just off the inside on the bend, fanned out some entering the lane, began to rally between horses and was forced to steady late in traffic. ILLINI DESTINY in the second flight just off the inside, angled out through the bend, came five wide into the stretch and could only make up minor ground. COACH ABS lugged in to bump HIGH HEIR shortly after the break, was just off the inside on the turn and gradually angled out to gain a clear path through the lane as he advanced. LITTLEBITEVEN chased from inside, also angled out some taking the bend, was four wide into the lane and gradually yielded. MARKY P steadied back from close quarters at the start, had the inside on the bend, floated out some into the stretch, moved back to the inside with a furlong left and slowly closed the gap. HURRICANE VAMP gradually faded from between rivals.
