Footnotes

BLUE GLITTER showed first, set the pace from outside, moved clear into the bend and angled in then steadily opened up under a drive through the lane. MY PRETTY HONEY pressed BLUE GLITTER early from inside, swung out to path three leaving the turn, moved clear for the place and maintained her position under steady urging. YAZOO MISS broke slowly and outward, progress three to five wide through the turn, altered out to the middle of the track upper stretch and caught SPRING RECITAL for third late. SPRING RECITAL broke a bit awkwardly, was prominent early between horses, started to drift out into the turn, was in path four at the top of the stretch, no match for the top pair and began to wear down the final sixteenth. BEAT THE HAMMER without speed between rivals, weaved around traffic early in the bend, was just off the inside entering the stretch, progressed to midstretch then leveled off. MY SILVER STAR was soon well back and outside, lost ground five then six wide taking the bend then gradually improved position between horses through the lane. LET LUCK BE A LADY an early contender toward the outside, was bumped on both sides into the turn, then clipped KARENSUE SLEW'S heels, altered out, stayed wide on the turn and improved position from the middle of the track deep stretch. PIXIE soon trailed, was just off the inside entering the bend, swung out into the lane, altered out widest of all upper stretch and lacked a significant response. KARENSUE SLEW reluctant to load, was an early contender from outside, angled in entering the turn, bumped with LET LUCK BE A LADY, came five wide into the stretch then gradually drifted out as she gave way. SHELBY ZEAL was prominent between horses for more than a furlong, steadied when her path was compromised into the turn, bumped with LET LUCK BE A LADY, altered in nearing the three-furlong marker and gave way the last quarter mile. There was a stewards' inquiry into the bumping incident entering the turn but no action taken after their review.
