Footnotes

WILL'S HONEY progressed between horses, waited for room while boxed in two wide on the turn, was steadied in tight quarters into the lane, altered out four wide upper stretch, rallied to gain the advantage with a sixteenth left and held off MINING FOR SILVER under steady urging. MINING FOR SILVER angled in some midway on the backstretch, was three then four wide taking the bend, lost his path to WILL'S HONEY upper stretch, got through just outside the latter with a furlong to go, closed well but too late. MENTO INK forwardly placed from the beginning, took over second while just off the rail on the turn, floated out a bit into the lane, threatened while all out between rivals deep stretch but lacked the extra needed in the waning yards. SANDS RED B broke in stride and was quickly clear, saved ground, tried hard through the stretch but did not have enough left. PORTERVILLE progressed just off the inside on the backstretch, had the rail on the turn, floated out some into the lane, gained a striking position, moved back to the rail midstretch, leveled off inside the final furlong and was altered outside SANDS RED B late. A J'S PAYDAY hard sent to race between horses in the second flight, lost position three wide on the turn, drifted out to path five entering the lane, floated out a bit upper stretch and was making up ground the last eighth. DAILY EXPRESS well back early, lost considerable ground widest taking the bend but showed a willingness to run deep stretch. SIR MILLER also void of speed, was just off the rail taking the turn and also closed the gap the final furlong. LEGATANGO chased the early speed just outside A J'S PLAYBOY, failed to keep up while fanning six wide into the lane and lacked a significant stretch response. SHILOH'S MIRACLE was a brief contender from outside, backed up five wide on the bend, lost further ground staying outside LEGATANGO entering the stretch and gave way.
