JUST ANOTHER FACT, bumped and forced into DOC'S BLAZE at the start, vied for the early lead from outside, was three wide on the bend, battled in the lane, got the advantage leaving midstretch then gradually edged ahead as she drifted out. MY GOAL, also bumped at the start, dueled for the lead inside from the beginning, did not have enough left. MANHATTAN MOMENT was kept close, three to four wide on the turn and found best stride too late in the lane. GOLD SPOT broke inward, bumping MY GOAL, raced in the second flight early, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail nearing the final furlong for a clear path but had no late bid. DOC'S BLAZE, bumped at the start as well, trailed from inside, was swung out five wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. STEF'S INHERITANCE bumped with JUST ANOTHER FACT at the break, vied for the lead between rivals but flattened out for the drive.
