Footnotes

TREASURE OF LOVE showed first, steadily angled in, was clear before finishing the first eighth, saved ground through the bend, began to tire deep stretch, was put to a drive, gradually drifted out but held on. DAWNS MISTAKE angled in as TREASURE OF LOVE came in just past the five furlong marker, bumped STORMY RACHEL, soon moved outside TREASURE OF LOVE, could not keep up with the latter nearing the turn, stayed just off the rail taking the bend, moved clear for second upper stretch, was all out the final furlong, steadily closed the gap, angled out as TREASURE OF LOVE came out the last sixteenth and was too late. DUSTER'S RAP progressed from outside, took over third while in path three on the turn, gradually drifted out through the stretch, was getting to the top pair in the late going, narrowly missed for second but proved easily best of the rest. STORMY RACHEL prominent from inside, was bumped after travelling the first sixteenth, came off the rail nearing the half mile pole, began to fade just off the inside on the turn, floated out some entering the stretch, moved back to the inside just past the eighth pole and lacked a significant response. K R A CENTSATION soon trailed, saved ground taking the turn, was just off the inside into the lane and was making up some ground as she drifted out deep stretch. NURSE GERTRUDE void of speed between rivals, was just off the inside on the bend, fanned out behind STORMY RACHEL into the lane, altered outside that one upper stretch then altered out as K R A CENTSATION came out in the waning yards. EASTERS DERBY GIRL gradually faded from between horses on the backstretch, three wide on the turn, swung out further for the stretch run and had no late bid.
