Footnotes

MERCURY EXPRESS sent from just off the inside, moved clear on the first turn, showed the way in hand on the backstretch, took the rail on the second bend, was roused entering the stretch, all out and narrowly held off YONA TORY. The latter stalked from along the rail, was angled two wide midway on the second turn, also put to a drive into the lane, drifted out some under left-handed pressure midstretch, was corrected, closed well but just missed. SIR REDFORD bumped just after the start, gradually progressed four wide, took over third inside the final furlong and pulled away for that position while slowly making up ground on the top pair. JOHNNY CADILLAC boxed in behind MERCURY EXPRESS early, altered out four wide midway on the backstretch, moved clear for third while three wide on the second turn, leveled off for the drive but proved easily best of the others. COOL EXTERIOR void of speed, gradually angled to the inside on the backstretch, progressed along the rail through the second bend and upper stretch then finished evenly. FATHER EDWIN drifted out just after the break, bumped SIR REDFORD, soon trailed from outside, in paths three then four taking the second turn and passed tired ones the last quarter mile without threatening. MASTER COMMANDER broke alertly, chased MERCURY EXPRESS from just outside to the second bend then gave way. SOON steadily faded from outside, angled in leaving the second turn and continued to retreat. JOE THE GENTLEMAN a brief contender between rivals, angled in some as JOHNNY CADILLAC came out midway on the backstretch, could not stay close, in paths three or four taking the second turn and was empty the last quarter mile.
