### Footnotes

PIMM'S O'CLOCK shared the lead from inside, moved ahead on the turn, was clear entering the stretch and gradually opened up on the field through the stretch while under urging. TRUE BEE forwardly placed between horses, progressed just off the rail on the turn, weaved in then back out as he took over second leaving the bend, was no match for PIMM'S O'CLOCK in the lane but proved easily second best. FANTASY MAN prominent from outside, was three then four wide through the bend, gave futile chase to the top pair in the stretch but was unchallenged for third. RUN WITH EAGLES steadied back from crowding at the start, steadily progressed from outside, lost ground four then five wide taking the turn, lugged in some after entering the final furlong and finished evenly. CRYPTO GULCH in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, failed to stay close along the rail on the turn and lacked the needed stretch bid. BOSTON OUTLAW fractious behind and in the gate, broke inward, bumping GREATTOEBEABEVER, dueling for the lead between horses, was two then three wide taking the turn and flattened out for the drive. KEYSTONE KID void of speed between horses, was just off the inside on the turn, swung out to path five for the stretch run and had no rally. GREATTOEBEABEVER a step slow at the break, was then bumped and forced into BOLD ROAR, steadied, saved ground and was never a factor. BOLD ROAR also a step slow at the start, was bumped solidly by GREATTOEBEABEVER, checked, trailed, taken outside midway on the backstretch, stayed well off the inside through the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and proved empty.
