Footnotes

CAMPO JOTI bumped with GRETA'S RAP at the break, was rated from inside, commenced her bid leaving the turn, altered out two wide upper stretch, gained the lead with a furlong left, was driven clear and in hand the final seventy yards. PRETTY HEIRESS chased from outside, was three wide on the turn, bumped and forced out some entering the lane and took over second deep stretch. PARTY DANCE without early speed from inside, made a strong move leaving the turn, gradually angled out inside the final furlong and caught GRETA'S REP for third. GRETA'S RAP bumped with CAMPO JOTI at the start, contested the pace from inside, moved clear leaving the bend but wore down the final furlong. LUCKY TIP trailed from outside, fanned out some for the drive and passed a couple tired ones late. SHINY STAR chased from between horses, was boxed and looking for room leaving the turn, bumped PRETTY HEIRESS as she forced her way to a clear path entering the stretch, began to yield, was altered out and checked off heels when her path was taken nearing the eighth pole and continued to fade. CITY WIFE bobbled as she broke on top, disputed the pace outside GRETA'S RAP, could not keep up leaving the turn, altered out some as CAMPO JOTI came out upper stretch and steadily gave way.
