FRIENDLY'S RAP in contention from the beginning, had the rail early in the bend, swung outside leaving the turn, came five wide into the lane, angled in to path three upper stretch, steadily closed the gap and came to even terms with ALASKAN COMET in the final strides. ALASKAN COMET advanced between horses, was three wide on the turn, moved to the inside entering the stretch, took over with a sixteenth left and held gamely. SHAME ON THE NIGHT was quickly clear, stayed just off the inside through the turn and gradually wore down for the drive. EXPLOSIVE DART progressed from outside, was four wide on the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track entering the stretch and found best stride too late. PRINCESS HONEYBEE closest to the early speed from outside, came into the stretch from path four and began to tire. BUGLE LADY was a contender between rivals on the backstretch but faded two wide on the bend. TOUGH TALKIN ANNIE was a factor from inside early but gave way along the rail on the turn. PAT'S LITTLE TRICK was away slowly, chased from off the inside, floated out to path five for the stretch run but had little to offer. I BUILT THAT was soon well back, saved ground taking the bend and was empty for the drive.
