Footnotes

NOBLE GRACE angled out early, circled rivals widest on the turn, was forced out to the middle of the track for the stretch run, took over inside the final sixteenth and began to draw off. DAWNS MISTAKE trailed well off the inside, angled in on the bend, closed well and took over second in the waning yards. EYE CAN FLAT RUN broke alertly, showed the way between horses, floated out some as she moved clear leaving the bend and slowly wore down inside the last eighth. DONTFLATERYOURSELF forwardly placed from outside, waited for room five wide leaving the turn, got through leaving the quarter pole, was altered out some for room into the lane, found best stride too late but was easily best of the rest. CLEOTA contested the pace from inside, could not stay with EYE CAN FLAT RUN leaving the turn, steadied briefly leaving the quarter pole, angled out to path four into the lane and continued to fade. SMITTENBUTSPITTIN' prominent between horses, was just off the inside on the turn, backed up some leaving the bend, altered out abruptly to stay clear of CLEOTA into the stretch and also continued to flatten. THATS DANCING pressed the pace from just outside, began to retreat leaving the turn, was checked hard behind traffic at the top of the stretch and steadily gave way. CHOCOLATE GOLD was a contender on the backstretch but faded three wide on the turn.
