Footnotes

LAURA'S TIME bumped and forced into CAPE KAROO shortly after the start, advanced between rivals, progressed along the rail on the turn, found herself behind HENNESSY DANCER upper stretch, altered out some nearing the furlong marker, responded to hand urging, gained the advantage just inside the sixteenth marker and began to draw off. SHAKEEL'S BEST squeezed and jostled shortly after the break, was forced out after entering the main track, closed the gap two wide on the turn, swung out leaving the bend, drifted to path five into the lane, gained second, leveled off in the late going and could only regain the place nearing the wire. SUNTAN BABY showed first but was soon pressing HENNESSY DANCER from outside, gained the lead from path three leaving the turn, moved clear, could not hold off LAURA'S TIME while all out deep stretch, was outfinished for second but easily best of the others. GREAT MILLENNIUM in contention between horses on the backstretch, made up ground on the leaders from along the rail on the turn but could not sustain her bid in the stretch. HENNESSY DANCER was quickly clear, showed the way staying off the inside, lost the lead while just off the rail entering the lane and continued to flatten. JULIANNE'S ARIA jostled between rivals early, stayed well off the inside through the turn and proved unresponsive in the stretch. CAPE KAROO bumped shortly after the start, steadily gave way from inside, began to be eased on the turn, finished the course and was walked off. INSCRIPT refused to break, was eventually extricated from the gate and galloped to the finish. It was determined after a stewards' inquiry that INSCRIPT was prepared for the start when the gate opened but refused.
