Footnotes

PALACHEE bobbed a bit at the break, quickly recovered to contest the pace from path three but inside RAY JAY, moved ahead just off the inside leaving the turn, was clear as he floated out further entering the stretch, slowly drifted out, though under steady right-handed urging, tried to bear out approaching the sixteenth pole, was corrected and maintained full control. COCKY BULL in the second flight from outside, was three to five wide taking the bend, slowly made up ground, angled inside PALACHEE near the sixteenth marker and moved clear for second in the waning yards. NOAH'S TRAVELER chased the pacesetters from between horses, waited for room two wide on the turn, gained a clear path just off the inside leaving the bend, threatened with a furlong to go but leveled off instead. ILLINI DESTINY hustled along between rivals, gained the rail into the turn and lacked the extra needed in the lane. LUCKY ALEC hesitated then made a large leap from the gate, progressed from outside, was widest taking the turn, closed the gap upper stretch then could not sustain his bid inside the final furlong. APACHE HONOR soon trailed, had the rail on the bend, floated out entering the stretch and failed to have a significant response. RAY JAY showed first, was soon disputing the pace from outside, could not stay with PALACHEE leaving the turn, angled in some upper stretch and continued to give way.
