Footnotes

HERE GUCCI steadied behind traffic shortly after the start, was settled outside, picked up her pace nearing the bend, four wide into the turn, swung out to the middle of the track entering the lane, made a strong move under urging, swept past SECA TREACE inside the final sixteenth and was drawing away through the waning yards. SECA TREACE tried to break outward, was quickly corrected, took over the lead from inside after travelling the first furlong, moved clear on the turn, was asked upper stretch, lengthened her advantage, began to wear down inside the final eighth but held onto second. TRIPPLE ZIP pressed the early speed from outside, angled in to be two wide on the turn, floated out further into the lane, slowly drifted out the last furlong and finished on even terms with SECA TREACE. CROSSWISE gradually altered out looking for a clear path on the backstretch, lost ground five then six wide through the bend, slowly closed the gap through the stretch and was altered out to stay clear of TRIPPLE ZIP nearing the wire. LIL SUSIE TOO in hand in traffic on the backstretch, was four wide on the turn, fanned out to path five for the stretch run and leveled off the final eighth. I DON'T THINK SO forwardly placed between horses, had to take the rail into the turn, came off the inside for a clear path upper stretch and flattened. TAP DAZZLER raced in contention just off the inside on the backstretch but faded on the bend. ETVOOPRAYPARTAY broke alertly, was hustled along between rivals, began to back up three then four wide taking the turn and gave way for the drive. PRIVATE KAPI trailed from between horses, just off the rail into the turn, floated out into the lane, moved inside for a clear path midstretch and steadily faded.
