Footnotes

SEYRULE quickly drew away, was let out on the second turn, hand urged in the lane and maintained full control while ridden out. SOUL COAXING settled between horses, moved to the rail on the backstretch, advanced on the second bend, moved clear for second upper stretch, came off the rail some inside the final furlong, was no match for the leader but easily second best. MASTER COMMANDER chased from outside, lost position while three wide on the second turn, fanned out further for the drive and caught KNOB CREEK for third in the waning yards. KNOB CREEK closest to the leader while inside, floated out to path three entering the stretch and weakened. BLACKHAWK RED in the second flight from outside, began to tire two wide on the second bend. ANNA'S GLORY without speed from outside, swung out widest for the drive and lacked a late bid. PURE PANICK bumped at the start, was two or three wide throughout and showed little. CADIN'S GOLD bumped PURE PANICK at the break, was soon far back, just off the inside on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch, was unresponsive and being eased in the late going.
