**Footnotes**

MOST stalked the pace from outside, went for the lead into the stretch, battled under a steady left whip, gradually drifted out the last eighth but caught SHE BE FAPIANO in the final strides. SHE BE FAPIANO hopped from the gate, moved up quickly to vie for the lead from inside, drew clear on the turn, fought gamely through the stretch but had to settle for second best. CONNIES MONSTER was settled, moved inward to take the turn just off the rail, swung out five wide for the stretch run, provided a mild bid and caught CITY PRAYER for third late. CITY PRAYER broke outward, prompted the pace from outside, took the turn four wide, lacked a rally in the lane, gained third in the deep stretch but lugged in nearing the wire and was outfinished. GRUVIANNA bumped with ASHLEY'S LUCK entering the main track and raced evenly from along the rail. DIAMOND ROCK CANDY disputed the pace outside SHE BE FAPIANO to the turn, could not sustain her speed after that and flattened out between rivals in the lane. ADDA DEVIL also bumped with ASHLEY'S LUCK early and failed to menace in a three-wide trip. ASHLEY'S LUCK was pinched between rivals once onto the main track, checked back and showed little.
