Footnotes

HURRICANE VAMP was sent to stalk the early speed from inside, gained the lead along the rail leaving the bend, floated out some into the stretch, moved clear and maintained control under a steady drive. JUST LUKE without early foot between horses, advanced three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to path seven for the drive then steadily closed the gap through the lane. GALLATINCOUNTYCAT in midpack on the backstretch, was just off the inside entering the turn, fanned five wide into the stretch then had to weave through traffic to advance. RAY JAY broke alertly, showed the way between rivals, drifted out some as he lost the lead leaving the turn and slowly wore down through the lane. PAJARITO void of speed from outside, was widest through the bend and showed late interest from the middle of the track. DALE'S DEAL trailed from between horses, swung five wide leaving the turn, passed tired ones upper stretch then finished evenly. B B'S FOR BOYS stumbled at the start, recovered quickly, raced just outside HURRICANE VAMP for nearly a half mile then began to fade. SILVERMART gradually backed up from just off the rail, floated out some entering the stretch and had little to offer. MR. CART displayed early speed from outside, was four to six wide taking the turn then gave way for the drive.
