Footnotes

STORMY MINNALOUSHE a step slow at the start, progressed not far off the inside, split rivals on the turn, lugged in some inside the final furlong, altered inside MANY STORMS with seventy yards left and got up at the wire. MANY STORMS broke in stride, showed the way just off the inside, was roused on the turn, all out through the lane and narrowly outfinished in a game effort. CAP'N SLICE hesitated at the start, trailed from outside, in path three on the bend, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and closed well. NICKEL HIDE in the second flight from inside, weakened for the drive. PAY O DAY without speed between horses, moved to the rail leaving the turn, altered out four wide midstretch then closed the gap some late without improving his position. ELI'S MAGIC trying to rear up at the start, was soon under control, advanced outside, lost ground five and six wide taking the bend, began to lug in as he weakened inside the furlong marker, bumped solidly with RUNNING ON TIME, was steadied and did not recover. RUNNING ON TIME lost his path shortly after the break, was quickly altered out, pressed the pacesetter from just outside, floated out to path four entering the stretch, began to fade between horses, drifted out after entering the final eighth, bumped hard with ELI'S MAGIC, was also steadied and finished evenly. VALLEROY also a step slow to break, had an uneven stride early, was just off the inside on the turn, swung out to path four leaving the bend and gradually angled out through the lane. ONE CLASSY OUTLAW ran in contention from outside on the backstretch but gave way four wide on the turn. ROSCOE'S ROCKET void of speed from outside, angled in on the turn and was empty for the stretch run.
