Footnotes

BRAZEN GEORGE soon had the lead from inside, lengthened just off the rail on the bend, drifted out entering the lane, was angled in upper stretch and steadily opened up under urging. GET READY HATERS in the second flight, was just off the inside taking the bend, moved clear for second upper stretch and could only hold his position late. ELUSIVE CLIMBER without early speed, gradually progressed just off or along the rail and caught UNO MACHO MAN for third in the waning yards. UNO MACHO MAN chased the leader while just outside GET READY HATERS, lost ground as he swung outside BRAZEN GEORGE into the lane and lugged in deep stretch. AMORLI was a factor between rivals but gave way three wide on the bend. TINGUN hustled up between horses, angled out some entering the turn, was steadied briefly and altered in near the three-eighths pole to be just off the inside, swung out to path five for the stretch run and was empty. TIMBERMAN a step slow at the break, failed to menace in a wide trip. GORE CANYON GOLD soon well back, angled in on the bend, fanned out some for the drive and proved empty. HARLEY'S CAT without early speed between horses, was squeezed early in the turn, clipped TIMBERMAN'S heels, fell, got up and finished the course and was walked off. There was a stewards' inquiry into HARLEY'S CAT'S fall early in the turn. After their review, TINGUN was disqualified and left unplaced for coming out without being clear and forcing HARLEY'S CAT into TIMBERMAN.
