Footnotes

HALF MOON BEAUTY stalked from outside, was roused from path three leaving the turn, slowly drifted out under a drive in the lane, moved clear inside the last furlong and continued to draw off through the waning yards. CANDY PASS a bit slow at the break, was hustled up between horses to gain the lead, stayed just off the inside taking the bend, floated out some into the stretch, was all out but no match for HALF MOON BEAUTY. DANCE DANCE SENORA bumped at the start, was prominent early, saved ground through the turn, gave futile chase to the top pair in the stretch but was easily best of the rest. UNO BLISS forwardly placed outside on the backstretch, faded just off the rail on the bend. STORMY RACHEL'S rider lost his irons shortly after entering the main track, regained his footing approaching the nine-sixteenths marker, saved ground and only passed tired ones. DONTFLATERYOURSELF broke outward, bumping DANCE DANCE SENORA, moved to the inside nearing the turn, swung out three wide early in the bend and gave way. GOOD WINNINGS stayed well off the inside throughout and showed little. FIRMLAND at the back between horses, had little left just off the inside on the bend.
