ASSORTED FACTS sprinted clear, saved ground through the bend and maintained full control under a steady drive in the lane. PERFECT SAND in midpack between rivals, was three wide on the turn, took over second inside the last eighth and could only pull clear for that position late. CENTRE ISLAND raced closest to ASSORTED FACTS from just outside and gradually wore down through the stretch. KAHOK advanced from inside on the backstretch, angled out on the turn, floated to path five entering the lane and lacked a sufficient bid. CLASSIC HENRY was prominent early, saved ground through the bend and weakened the final furlong. REGENT'S HOPE bobbed at the break, was pinched between horses shortly after that, steadied, settled, angled in entering the turn, swung out to path four into the stretch and passed tired ones. KEYSTONE KID failed to menace in a wide trip. DAPPLED also squeezed leaving the chute, was checked, progressed between horses, altered inside on the turn and came up empty for the drive. EVERYBODYLVSRAYMOND void of speed between rivals, gave way three wide on the turn.
