**Footnotes**

STARIANA progressed inside to share the lead after the first furlong and a half, moved clear on the turn and steadily opened up with mild encouragement through the lane. SOCIALLY JADED in contention between horses on the backstretch, took the rail into the bend, moved clear for second upper stretch, was all out under steady urging the last eighth and continued to lengthen her hold on the place. CASSIES HOPE an early factor from outside, failed to keep up three wide on the turn, fanned to path five for the stretch run and got up for third late. CART'S CRUSIN bumped and forced into GOOD WINNINGS leaving the chute, was then shuffled back, angled toward the outside, advanced as she followed CASSIES HOPE into the turn, swung outside the latter for the drive and improved her position late without threatening. GOOD WINNINGS bumped and also shuffled back leaving the chute, was rated just off the inside, lost considerable ground fanning seven wide entering the lane and passed tired ones the final furlong. HENNESSY DANCER broke in stride, was challenged from inside before finishing the first quarter mile, could not stay with STARIANA while just off the inside and well clear of the rest through the bend, floated out to path three for the stretch run, began to tire and gradually lugged in the last eighth. ANGELORE well placed inside on the backstretch, faded on the turn, swung out to path four into the lane and had little left. SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL angled in some leaving the chute, bumped solidly with CART'S CRUSIN, quickly recovered to press the early speed from just inside, was steadied when her path was taken at the half mile pole and flattened just off the rail on the bend. CLASSIC RETURN was soon well back, moved to the rail on the turn and steadily faded while allowed to coast through the stretch.
